

HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

When used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, the product is safe for humans and the environment, in compliance with Regulation (EC) 1272/2008 (CLP).

Wash the hair with shampoo. Pat dry throughly with a towel. Spread the product evenly along the length ends. Use a comb if it helps. Leave for 5 and 20 minutes, depending on the required intensity of the shine. Rinse thoroughly and the dry. Do not shampoo again.

Product for professional use.

Keep out of reach of children.

FIRST AID MEASURES

Contact with the eyes: remove contact lenses if present and rinse carefully with plenty of water; if irritation persists, seek medical advice.

Ingestion: if swallowed, contact the nearest Poison Centre or seek medical advice.

Contact with the skin: rinse skin immediately with plenty of water: if irritation persists, seek medical advice.

FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

In the event of fire, use water mist, chemical powder, carbon dioxide.

ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Collect the spilled product with sand, sawdust or cloths and transfer to suitable containers for disposal according to regulations. Wash contaminated areas with plenty of water. Never return the spilled product to the original container. Never reuse the spilled product.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling

- Always follow the instructions on the packaging or on the accompanying leaflet, ring or collar.
- Do not use the product for any purpose other than the ones described in the instructions.
- Avoid mixing with other products or similar products or with different substances which are not indicated in the specific instructions.
- Never return the spilled product to the original container for reuse.
- Disposable gloves are recommended.
- Do not use on eyelashes and eyebrown.
- Contains pigments.
- May cause allergic reaction reactions. It is advisable to perform a sensitivity or patch test before using.
- Avoid direct contact with the eyes.
- Keep out of the reach of children.
- Keep away from direct light and warm sources.

Continuous exposure to cleaning agents (soap, shampoo, liquid detergents) for professional reasons may deplete the hydrolipidic film and horny layer which form the skin's natural barrier. The depletion of this barrier may result in lesions of the skin, which is then more exposed to external agents.

In such conditions, handling other products normally used during professional activities without the necessary precautions (e.g. gloves or specific PPE), may cause intolerance which, in the long term, may lead to more severe forms.

Storage

Store in dry, well-ventilated areas (room temperature).

Do not store or use the product in the vicinity of open flames, heat sources, electrical equipment or direct sunlight.

Close containers well after use.
