Section 02 – Hazard Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

This is a personal care or cosmetic product that is safe for consumers and other users under intended and reasonably foreseeable use.

POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS:

Eye: Contact may cause mild, transient irritation. Some redness and/or stinging may occur.

Skin: Not expected to be irritating, sensitizing, photo allergenic or phototoxic when used as intended. If irritation occurs following intended use or prolonged contact it is expected to be mild and transient.

The complete ingredient list for the finished product(s) is as follow:

Water (Aqua/Eau), PVP, Magnesium Sulfate, Sucrose, Glycerin, PEG-17 Dimethicone, Polysorbate 20, Phenoxyethanol, Oleth-20, PEG-40 Hydrogenated Castor Oil, Caprylyl Glycol, Fragrance (Parfum), Methylparaben, Disodium EDTA, Aminomethyl Propanol, Methylisothiazolinone, Butylphenyl Methylpropional, Citral, Coumarin, Hexyl Cinnamal, Limonene, Linalool.

Section 04 – First Aid Measures

Eye: Thorough rinsing for 15-20 minutes of the effected eye with water is recommended. If discomfort or irritation persists, contact a physician.

Skin Problem: Discontinue use of product. Apply cold compresses to affected areas to relieve any discomfort. If discomfort persists, contact a physician.
